Landowners are solely responsible to ensure that diversion and recharge are in compliance with federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations and by its signature above, agree to indemnify and hold harmless the MSGSA for any activity not in compliance with law. Should any recharge used as a credit in the future be determined invalid by any regulatory body, landowner will be required to make up the pumping credit.
