POTENTIAL UPDATES TO LRP FOR 2023 SOLICITATION

LRP Application

- Update dates
 - Solicitation period
 - Baseline period
- Update maximum duration to 4 years
- Replace requirement for “contiguous” lands w/ requirement for consistent lands
- Add clarifying instructions to streamline application process

LRP Agreement

- New section stating baseline water use
- Clarify prohibition on net expansion of irrigated lands
- Add text on participant’s ability to document their water use reduction
- Add “fallow” definition
- Slight re-organization for clarity

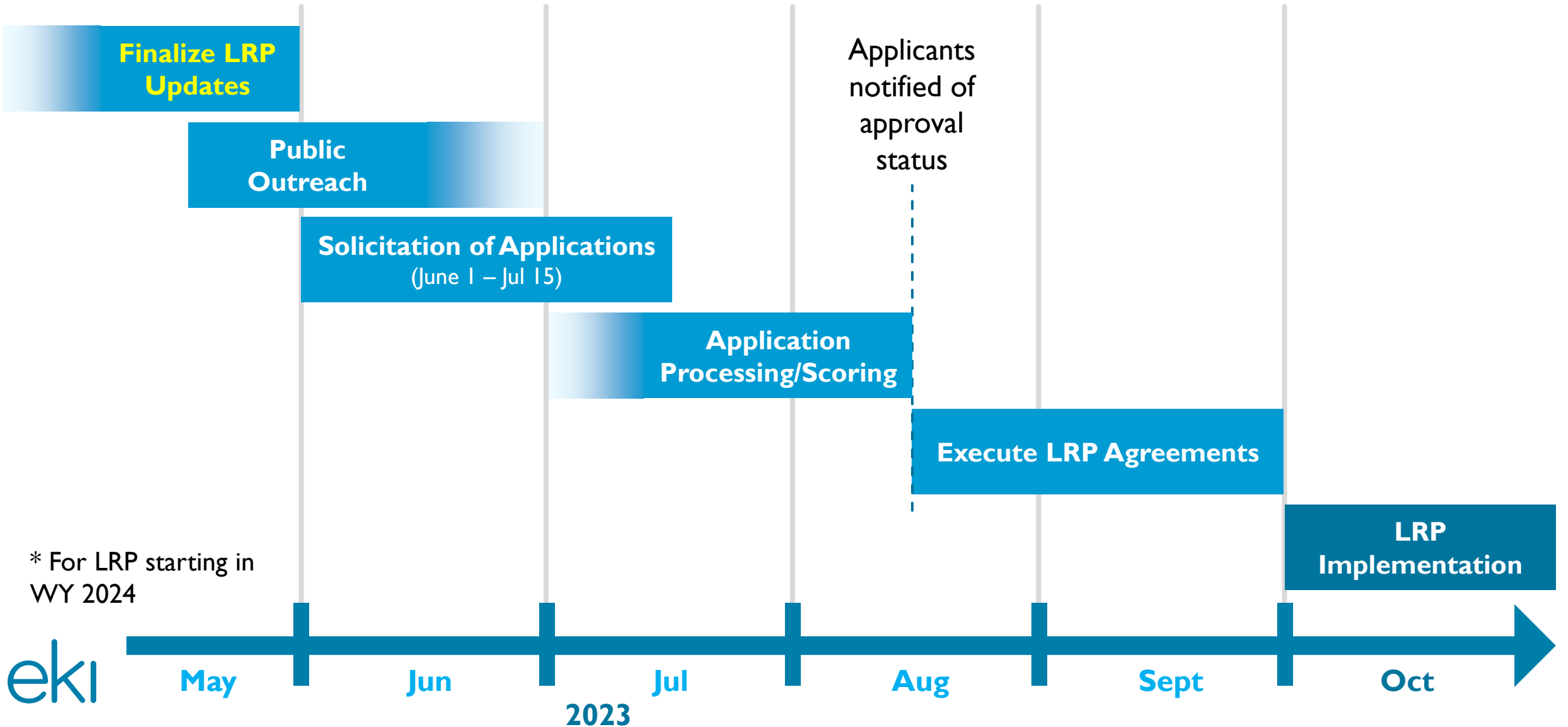
Scoring Process

- Increase weight of water savings and cost criteria?
- Use OpenET-based water use calculation for scoring?
- Eligibility changes?

- Revise to describe all changes to Application, Agreement and Process
